Course materials comprise load exercises and load charts for the crane with which the trainee is working.

Hands-On Safety Training would take up more than half of the course curriculum. The practical training section is the most effective method to improving and developing personal skill levels. Just licensed journeyman crane instructors are selected to teach the courses. Our instructors possess numerous years of industry experience.

Optional testing mechanisms are offered for all of our courses. Students will usually write tests both prior to and following training. A skills test is generally administered for programs which consist of H.O.S.T. People training will be graded and tested.
