MSDS or Material Safety Data Sheet training is likewise covered in the course. Though not directly related to the utilization of a lift truck, MSDS training is important in case an operator notices a leaking container or damages a container containing toxic materials. MSDS sheets list the right methods of dealing with spills, the products and their effects on people.
