General Hazards

The most common workplace hazards consist of falls, slips and trips. The potential for falls, slips and trips is increased when workers are moving materials on various kinds of floor surfaces and on various levels. Another common hazard is getting hit by falling objects. This is usually caused by failure to correctly stack objects on shelves and other surfaces. Back injuries because of incorrect lifting techniques are one more common danger.

There are inherent risks in utilizing and working around workplace machines. Accidents could normally be caused from the improper use of conveyors, hand trucks and forklift trucks. Warehouse tools, like for example pallets, skids, strapping and cutting tools, need to be utilized cautiously throughout loading, packing and unpacking.
